



Pan-O-Prog Grand Parade Saturday, July 13th – Parade step-off 5:30

Guidelines, rules, and responsibilities – please share with all your participants!

- **Parade line-up starts at 3:30**; Target all parade units in place by 5:00.
- Inform your units of your unit line-up number found in your email.
- Parade line-up will assemble along 210th Street West, Heron Way (adjacent to 210th Street W) and on Holyoke Avenue south of 210th Street W. See attached map for details.
 - Most Units will enter east staging from East on 210th Street W and Hamburg Ave
 - Shriner units will enter west staging at 210th Street W and Dodd Blvd
 - High School bands will enter in the south staging area at Hwy 70 and Holyoke Ave
- Entrance to staging at 210th Street W and Hamburg Ave will be a west bound one-way starting at 3:30 to provide flow for participant drop off. It will be ONLY one-way – east to west with exit at 210th and Dodd until 5:00 pm.
- Team Pan-O-Prog parade support will be available for questions and direction during staging.
- The Parade route starts at 210th and Holyoke, proceeds north on Holyoke to Heritage Drive and goes west on Heritage Drive to Iberia Avenue where it ends. The route is 1.2 miles long.
- Returning this year – parade units will alternate going around each side of the roundabout at Holyoke Ave and Hwy 50. Parade support will direct you accordingly.
- Parking at the end of the parade is available to allow for an easy post-parade exit. Please consider dropping your cars in advance of the parade and catching our shuttle bus back to staging. The shuttle starts at 3:30 and makes continuous loops between McGuire Middle School (start) and Heritage and Idealic Ave (by O'Reilly's) at the end of the parade. Please allow time for travel.
- Bands and others who need to change clothes will be able to use McGuire Middle School located in the band staging area.
- Visiting Royalty and Dignitaries are invited to the Royalty reception from 4:00 to 5:30 at the Lakeville Arts Center at the corner of Holyoke and 210th.
- **No items may not be thrown** from vehicles or floats at any time. Walkers may distribute items by traveling within three feet of the curb. Safety is our top priority.
- No water balloons or water guns are allowed in the parade.
- Water will be available at parade line-up and at end of the parade for your participants.
- Pan-O-Prog cannot be responsible for acts of God. If weather appears to be a factor, parade information will be posted on our web page at panoprogram.org and on our Facebook page.
