

# STANDARD HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

1. We understand that we are participating in this parade on a totally voluntary basis and that we are NOT under any obligation or compulsion to participate in these activities. We further understand that this parade is sponsored by the Lakeville Panorama of Progress organization (Pan-O-Prog) and NOT the City of Lakeville, MN.
2. Our members have received a briefing on this parade, including the distribution of any “hand outs.” They have a basic understanding of the activities involved in this parade. We further considered the risks involved in this parade and do willingly choose to participate.
3. We understand that our own safety is our responsibility and that organizers of this parade would rather have the parade halted than to cause injury to any person or damage to any property. We hereby agree to assume the risks of injury which may be involved in the activities of this parade and hereby agree to hold harmless, defend and indemnify the Pan-O-Prog organization and its volunteers, City of Lakeville and its elected officials and any organization, whether private or public, which may be involved in this parade.
4. We further assume the responsibility for damage or injury to any other person, private property or possessions that we may cause through any of our actions whether deliberate or accidental.
5. As parade participants, we understand we are responsible for our own personal health/medical and liability insurance that will cover us/them during the parade. This personal health/medical insurance policy must be in effect and will be used in case of injury. We further understand that Pan-O-Prog, or any other agency, will not cover any medical costs incurred due to injury during this voluntary participation in this parade.
6. **We understand that items like candy, water bottles, posters, coupons, souvenirs, etc. may be handed out. We assume full responsibility in safely distributing them to the spectators. All members distributing candy, etc. will be twelve years of age or older and have been briefed on the process. All items being distributed must be hand delivered to the sides of the road to within three feet of the curb along the entire parade route. Absolutely nothing may be thrown from a vehicle in the parade route!!!**

**\*\* For spectator safety reasons violators of item six (6) will be immediately removed from the parade and will not be allowed to participate in next year’s parade!!!\*\***

7. We understand that THIS DOCUMENT MUST BE SIGNED AND RECEIVED BY THE PARADE COMMITTEE BEFORE OUR ORGANIZATION WILL BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PARADE.
8. We have read the entire contents of this document and totally understand/accept the circumstances and conditions under which we may participate in this parade. We have shared this information with our unit members and, if minors are involved, their parents have been advised of the details.
