Dear Parade Participant,

We would like you to consider participating in Lakeville's 56th Annual Grand Parade. The parade is comprised of approximately 120 units along a 1.2-mile route. It proceeds at a fast pace lasting about 2 hours with a full street of an estimated 20,000 spectators lining the entire parade route. This year's parade will be on **Saturday, July 9th, 2022, beginning @ 5:30 PM.** As you may already know, our high-quality parade is regarded as one of the "very best" in Minnesota.

The Pan-O-Prog committee prides itself on accommodating the needs of our participants. We provide the following services to our visiting parade units:

- Portable toilet facilities in the line-up area.
- Water to parade participants in the line-up and at the end of the parade.
- Easy access out of town at the end of the parade route.

If you are interested in participating, please fill out the enclosed enrollment and Standard Hold Harmless agreement forms and return them along with required insurance documents to the address indicated on the form.

Please respond as soon as possible, **but not later than June 30th.** We are limiting the number of parade entries to 120 units. This will allow for a two-hour, better managed, higher quality parade. Unfortunately, it also means we will not be able to accommodate everyone wishing to participate. After accepting our community leaders, performing units, corporate sponsors, and the business/political paying units, we will then allocate the remaining spots to get the parade to 120 units in length.

Applications received after June 1st will be assessed an additional late entry of \$100.00 for a total of \$600.00 minimum.

Participants that are only Walking:

- Must have valid Homeowners or Renters Insurance

Participants that are using an Automobile or Motorized Unit:

- Must have valid Insurance having a combined single limit of no less than \$500,000.
- Provide proof of coverage

Participants that are Businesses:

- Must have Comprehensive Liability Insurance having a limit of no less than \$1,000,000 (per occurrence) covering bodily injury, personal injury and property damage.
- If using Automobile or Motorized Unit, coverage with combined single limit of no less than \$500,000
- Must provide a certificate of insurance with the following provisions:

STANDARD HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

Name: Pan-O-Prog Parade

Location: Lakeville, MN

Date/Time: Saturday, July 9th, 2022 @ 5:30 PM

1. We understand that we are participating in this parade on a totally voluntary basis and that we are NOT under any obligation or compulsion to participate in these activities. We further understand that this parade is sponsored by the Lakeville Panorama of Progress organization (Pan-O-Prog) and NOT the City of Lakeville, MN.
 2. Our members have received a briefing on this parade, including the distribution of "handouts." They have a basic understanding of the activities involved in this parade. We further considered the risks involved in this parade and do willingly choose to participate.
 3. We understand that our own safety is our responsibility and that organizers of this parade would rather have the parade halted than to cause injury to any person or damage to any property. We hereby agree to assume the risks of injury which may be involved in the activities of this parade and hereby agree to hold harmless, defend and indemnify the Pan-O-Prog organization and it's volunteers, City of Lakeville and it's elected officials and any organization whether private or public, which may be involved in this parade.
 4. We further assume the responsibility for damage or injury to any other person, private property or possessions that we may cause through any of our actions whether deliberate or accidental.
 5. As parade participants we understand we are responsible for our own personal health/medical and liability insurance that will cover us/them during the parade. This personal health/medical insurance policy must be in effect and will be used in case of injury. We further understand that Pan-O-Prog, nor any other agency; will cover any medical costs incurred due to injury during this voluntary participation in this parade.
 6. **We understand that items like candy, water bottles, posters, coupons, souvenirs, etc. may be handed out. We assume full responsibility in safely distributing them to the spectators. All members distributing candy, etc. will be twelve years of age or older and have been briefed on the process. All items being distributed must be hand delivered to the sides of the road to within four feet of the curb along the entire parade route. Absolutely nothing may be thrown from a vehicle in the parade route!!!**
- ** For spectator safety reasons violators of above will be immediately removed from the parade and will not be allowed to participate in next year's parade!!****
7. We understand that THIS DOCUMENT MUST BE COMPLETED AND RECEIVED BY THE PARADE COMMITTEE BEFORE OUR ORGANIZATION WILL BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PARADE.
